The analysis of the survey conducted shows that, 85% students were highly satisfied on the Teaching Learning Process of the institution. Students have expressed satisfaction over the syllabus covered in their classes and laboratories. The survey questions include the parameters like facilities, syllabus, course outcomes and related activities in the college revealed that the students are highly satisfied. At the same time the students highly appreciated and satisfied with the implementation of learning outcome based curriculum which includes communication of teacher with students, teaching methodology, seminar works and its follow up made by the faculty .Teaching with ICT tools by the faculty along with the appropriate teaching Pedagogy has been rated high in the survey.












6. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.






8. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.


